SCHOOL TARGETS AND STRATEGIES

Mathematics Target:

To increase the percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score 4 or higher on the Spring 2022 Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) Mathematics Assessment.

Summary of Mathematics Strategies:

- All instructional staff will engage in job-embedded professional learning and collaborative planning with a focus on accessing the math, making connections between and among representations, as well as eliciting key ideas from students in each lesson.
- Professional learning will be provided on strengths-based teaching and learning connected to building a positive mathematics identity among students, and integrating funds of knowledge.

Literacy Target

To increase the percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score 4 or higher on the Spring 2022 Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) Literacy Assessment.

Summary of Literacy Strategies:

- Team and embedded Professional Learning will be provided on explicit instructional practices and resources for grade level foundational skills.
- Team Professional Learning will be provided on formative assessments analysis to guide instruction.
- Team professional learning will be provided on how to give student feedback.

Belonging Target

To decrease the percentage of Office Discipline Referrals (ODRs) for all grade-level students.

Summary of Belonging Strategies

- Provide and engage in monthly professional learning for the entire staff focused on culturally responsive teaching, anti-racism in the classroom, and teaching with poverty in mind.
- Staff will engage in quarterly professional learning focused on teaching practices to meet the needs of diverse learners.
